- We are pleased to inform you that the BC Pediatric Diabetes Day is now offering a limited number of travel grants for eligible participants.
- Deadline to submit your application is [January 20, 2019](#); notifications of acceptance will be sent to you by January 25, 2019.
- Accepted applications will receive up to \$500 to help with travel costs and accommodation. You will be required to pay first and then receive your reimbursement after the conference (this may take 4-6 weeks). Receipts for travel and accommodation are required.
- In order to be eligible for a travel grant, you must be an Allied Health participant (Diabetes Nurse Educator, Dietitian, Nurse or Nurse Practitioner, Social Worker, etc) and your travel must involve a flight purchase. Only 1 - 2 people will be selected from each center.
