Key Responsibilities:

- Provide diabetes education and care across the lifespan (Pre-Diabetes, Gestational Diabetes, Type 2, and high-risk individuals).
- Conduct point-of-care testing, vision screening, and follow-up visits.
- Review and maintain client medical histories; communicate findings to primary care providers.
- Collaborate with other healthcare professionals to develop care plans and coordinate services.
- Deliver individual and group education sessions using culturally relevant approaches.
- Support community awareness initiatives such as conferences, workshops, and health events.
- Compile and manage health records and statistical reports.
- Advocate for clients and act as a resource to other healthcare staff.
