We are seeking a **part-time subcontract Registered Dietitian with a Certified Diabetes Educator (CDE) designation** to join our growing virtual care team. This role is ideal for a clinician who enjoys working with adults managing diabetes, insulin resistance, cardiometabolic disease, and weight concerns, and who values autonomy within a supportive interdisciplinary environment.

This is a **virtual subcontract position**, with flexibility to grow hours over time based on availability and client demand.

- Provide **one-on-one virtual nutrition counselling** to adults, with a primary focus on:

 - Prediabetes and insulin resistance
 - Weight management and cardiometabolic health
 - Chronic disease management
 - Additional areas of practice as needed, include weight loss, digestive health, and more
- Deliver care using the **Nutrition Care Process** (assessment, intervention, monitoring, evaluation) within scope of practice



- Apply **behaviour change counselling and motivational interviewing** to support sustainable outcomes
 - Communicate and collaborate with **primary care providers, nurse practitioners, and specialists** as appropriate
 - Complete **timely, thorough charting and documentation** in accordance with PHIPA and professional standards
 - Participate in **team meetings, case discussions, and continuing education**
 - Support practice growth through excellent client experience and retention, with marketing and administrative support from NutriProCan
